



Special Seating Arrangements for CACC 223/2022

There will be special seating arrangements in **Court No. 1, 3/F, High Court Building** for the captioned case. Apart from those seats reserved for the press, parties concerned and the applicants' family and friends, the rest (including Court No. 1, the Court Extension at the Court Lobbies on 3/F and 4/F with live broadcast of the proceedings) will be assigned to members of the public on a first-come-first-served and one-person-one-ticket basis. Since the number of seats are limited, only those members of the public who have secured admission tickets will be allowed to enter the designated public galleries. They will otherwise need to wait at the queuing area outside the entrance on the Lower Ground 4th Floor (LG4) of the High Court Building for stand-by tickets (around 50). Once all tickets (admission and stand-by) have been distributed, members of the public will be informed as soon as practicable.

Members of the public are advised to refer to the Daily Cause List to check the actual hearing date and time. Admission tickets will be distributed 2 hours before the start of the hearing on the same day at the queuing area outside the entrance on the Lower Ground 4th Floor (LG4) of the High Court Building. Those who have obtained admission tickets shall proceed to the 3/F for admission to the courtroom/court extension under the guidance of the venue officers after undergoing security screening procedures. Admission tickets will be distributed in the following sequence –

Attention:

- For members of the public, only admission ticket holders are allowed access to Court No. 1 and the Court Extensions. All persons shall present their tickets for checking.
- Admission tickets issued on the day are valid for the hearing at Court No. 1 on that day only.
- If ticket holders do not enter the court (or court extensions) or have left their seats for 15 minutes or more, the tickets concerned will become invalid and the seats concerned will be released to other court users.
