



Advice to court users visiting Judiciary premises during the period of general adjournment of court proceedings

In view of public health consideration, the Judiciary strongly advises all court users who need to come to the Judiciary premises in relation to attendance of urgent and essential businesses including court proceedings to pay attention to and take the following actions:

- (a) To ensure that their body temperature is normal and their physical conditions are well before coming to the court for urgent and essential hearings and/or matters;
- (b) The Government has announced the mandatory quarantine requirement for all people entering Hong Kong from the Mainland, or from other places but have visited the Mainland during the 14 days preceding the date of arrival with effect from 8 February 2020. Court users falling under this category are advised to apply to the court for permission of absence/inform the court with reasons for absence as appropriate;
- (c) To put on a surgical mask when entering Judiciary premises, in particular when interacting with other people within the premises;
- (d) To disinfect their hands after entering and/or touching any handles or pressing any buttons etc. as far as practicable; and
- (e) To wear a surgical mask at appropriate times even during the court proceedings, unless otherwise as directed by the presiding Judge or Judicial Officer.
