e-Appointment Service for
Application for Registration of Enduring Power of Attorney

With effect from 6 July 2026, Donor and/or Attorney(s) of an Enduring Power of Attorney, or their representing law firm, are required to make an online appointment in advance via the e-Appointment System for the purpose of attending the High Court Registry to submit an application for registration of an Enduring Power of Attorney. Registered user of “iAM Smart” may use the auto form-filling function of “iAM Smart” to provide relevant personal data for booking the appointment.
