THE COURT OF FINAL APPEAL LIBRARY

Apart from the Court of Final Appeal Judges and their staff, the Court of Final Appeal Library also serves legal practitioners and parties on the days when their cases are being heard at the Court of Final Appeal.

1. Opening Hours

Mondays to Fridays

Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays

2. Admission to the Library

Legal practitioners and parties to legal proceedings may use the Court of Final Appeal Library on the days when their cases are being heard at the Court of Final Appeal. However, the Judiciary Administrator reserves the right to decline any requests for admission to the Court of Final Appeal Library.

3. Borrowing of Books

- (a) The legal practitioners, who hold a Judiciary library card, may borrow books from the Court of Final Appeal Library during the Library opening hours on the days when their cases are being heard at the Court of Final Appeal. They must return the books to the Library before its closing time on the same day.
- (b) When a book borrowed is not returned before the specified time on the due date, the borrower will have to pay a late charge of \$50 per day or part of the day.
- (c) Books marked 'not to be taken away' or with red labels on the book spines and judgment bound volumes are not for borrowing.
- (d) Readers or borrowers should report to the Library staff immediately if they notice any defect in or damage to a book. They will be held responsible for any loss or damage to any books in their charge.

4. Other Matters

- (a) Smoking, eating and drinking are prohibited in the Court of Final Appeal Library.
- (b) Library users should not cause a nuisance to any person in the Court of Final Appeal Library.
- (c) Library users are to be responsible for safe custody of their personal belongings.
- (d) The Judiciary Administrator may, by notices displayed in the Court of Final Appeal Library, make provisions for the maintenance of order and the proper use of the Library.
- (e) The Judiciary Administrator may suspend the right of any library users to use the Court of Final Appeal Library if they fail to comply with the above and/or other library notices.
